

# Selectiecriteria WEG 2018 Tryon

Goedgekeurd door de Raad van Bestuur van de KBRSF op 20/12/2017

Welk resultaat moet een combinatie behalen om selecteerbaar te zijn voor de wereldspelen?

Selecteerbare combinaties = Dit zijn de combinaties die nog in aanmerking kunnen komen voor de selectie van de wereldspelen.

Het is de bedoeling de combinatie(s) te sturen met de meeste kans op succes!

## 1. Alle disciplines

Entries in Principle:

### **Algemene Bepalingen:**

Beslissingsbevoegdheid selecties:

<u>Jumping:</u>	team manager (verantwoording aan topsportcel)
<u>Dressuur:</u>	team manager (verantwoording aan topsportcel)
<u>Eventing:</u>	team manager (verantwoording aan topsportcel)
<u>Para-equestrian:</u>	chef d'équipe in samenspraak met topsportcel
<u>Endurance:</u>	sportieve commissie (na overleg met chef d'équipe) doet een voorstel aan het directiecomité die de finale beslissing neemt
<u>Reining:</u>	sportieve commissie (na overleg met chef d'équipe) doet een voorstel aan het directiecomité die de finale beslissing neemt
<u>Mennen:</u>	sportieve commissie (na overleg met chef d'équipe) doet een voorstel aan het directiecomité die de finale beslissing neemt
<u>Voltige:</u>	Nog geen internationale resultaten die verantwoorden dat er gestreden kan worden tussen de wereldtop. Daarom heeft de raad van bestuur van KBRSF beslist om geen voltigeurs af te vaardigen naar Tryon.

- Combinaties die in aanmerking willen komen voor selectie, moeten naast de vereiste criteria ook de engagementsverklaring ondertekenen en het programma volgen dat in samenspraak met de team manager/chef d'équipe zal opgelegd worden.
- Alle personen op de accreditatielijst dienen de code of conduct te ondertekenen, zoniet kan geen accreditatie verleend worden. Het is de betrokken atleet die hiervoor verantwoordelijk is.
- De plaats van de ruiter/combinatie op de FEI ranking(s) is niet bepalend voor de selectie.
- De team manager/chef d'équipe maakt een selectie uit de selecteerbare combinaties, rekening houdend met hierbij vermelde criteria en richtlijnen.
- Elk paard moet door de teamdierenarts gekeurd worden vooraleer een definitieve selectie mogelijk is.
- Indien er minder combinaties in aanmerking komen voor een definitieve selectie dan er mogelijke selecteerbare plaatsen zijn, kunnen team manager /topsportcel/chef d'équipe combinaties selecteren die de vereiste resultaten benaderen en dit wegens uitzonderlijke omstandigheden.
- Naast resultaten zal de team manager/chef d'équipe bij een selectie steeds rekening houden met volgende eigenschappen van de atleet: teamspirit, respect, eerlijkheid, zelfkritiek, discipline, vertrouwen, de wil om een topprestatie te leveren en passie.
- De FEI-criteria opgenomen in dit document zijn deze van dd 30 augustus 2017. Het is aan de atleet zelf om eventuele aanpassingen aan deze criteria nauw op te volgen.

## 2. Jumping (19-23/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **2.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 1 January 2017  
End: 13 August 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018

**Definite entries:** 10 September 2018

### **Minimum qualification criteria**

#### **Article 305 QUALIFICATIONS**

1. HORSES

The Horses must be nine years old or more.

2. ATHLETES

The Championship is limited to Athletes who have reached or will reach their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday during the year of the Championship.

3. CERTIFICATES OF CAPABILITY

Only those Athletes and Horses who are likely to be able to complete the Championship may be entered. NFs must send to the FEI a Certificate of Capability to this effect (see GRs). Athletes and Horses are not required to qualify as combinations.

This Certificate of Capability must include a record of the results obtained in Competitions satisfying the requirements as laid down in the Jumping Rules.

The procedure for qualification, laid down under JRs Annex VIII, must be strictly followed.

Upon arrival at the Championship, Chefs d'Equipe can exchange Athletes and Horses at will, whether originally qualified as combinations or not. After the first Championship Competition, no further changes are permitted.

### **Annex VIII Qualification Procedure for Olympic Games, World and Continental Jumping Championships**

1. NFs must declare in writing to the FEI by a fixed date their intention to enter a team or individuals. Except for the Olympic Games Athletes and Horses are not required to qualify as combinations.
2. For the Olympic Games, Athletes/Horses must achieve the minimum eligibility requirements between 1 January of the year preceding the Olympic Games until the closing date for nominated entries, or a date established by the FEI. Refer to the FEI Regulations for Equestrian Events at Olympic Games for the qualification procedure for the Olympic Games.
3. **For the World Championship** Athletes/Horses must achieve the minimum eligibility requirements between 1 January of the year preceding the World Championship until the closing date for nominated entries, or a date established by the FEI. Those who achieve the results according to any of the following paragraphs will obtain a Certificate of Capability:
  - 3.1. Athletes and Horses with a score of not more than eight penalties in the team Competition (first or second round) at the last European or World

- Championship or Pan American Games or Olympic Games or other Continental CH for Sen.
- 3.2. Athletes and Horses that have completed the third Competition at the last World Championship, or the individual Final at the last European Championship or Pan American Games or Olympic Games or other Continental Championship for Seniors.
  - 3.3. Athletes and Horses with a Score of zero penalties in the first round of two FEI World Cup™ Competitions at selected outdoor CSI1\*-W, CSI2\*-W and CSI3\*-W Events. Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of an FEI World Cup™ Competition at a selected outdoor CSI4\*-W Event with a Score of not more than four penalties. Athletes and Horses that have completed the first round of an FEI World Cup™ Competition at a selected outdoor CSI5\*-W Event with a Score of not more than eight penalties.
  - 3.4. Athletes and Horses with a Score of zero penalties in the first round of two Grand Prix Competitions at selected CSI3\* outdoor Events.
  - 3.5. Athletes and Horses with a Score of not more than four penalties in the first round of a Grand Prix Competition at a CSI4\* outdoor Event.
  - 3.6. Athletes and Horses with a Score of not more than eight penalties in the first round of a Grand Prix Competition at a CSI5\* outdoor Event.
  - 3.7. Athletes and Horses with a Score of not more than four Penalties in the first round or zero Penalties in the second round of a Nations Cup Competition at a selected CSIO3\* or CSIO4\* outdoor Event, or with a Score of not more than four Penalties in the first round of the Grand Prix Competition at the same Event (or in the first round of the FEI World Cup™ Competition if it is the Grand Prix at this Event), provided the courses of these Competitions are built according to the specifications set forth in paragraph 6 below. The course plans of these Competitions must be sent to the FEI for approval prior to the Event.
  - 3.8. Athletes and Horses with a Score of not more than eight penalties in the first or second round of a Nations Cup Competition at a CSIO5\* outdoor Event, or with a Score of not more than eight penalties in the first round of the Grand Prix Competition at the same Event (or in the first round of the FEI World Cup™ Competition if it is the Grand Prix at this Event).
5. For CSI and CSIO Events mentioned above, selection will be made from Events which take place from the 1 January the year preceding the Games or Championship until the closing date for nominated entries, or a date to be fixed by the FEI. A list of Events will be published by the FEI in the year preceding the Olympic Games or FEI Championship.
  6. Selected Nations Cup, Grand Prix Competitions and FEI World Cup™ qualifying Competitions must meet the following specifications: consist of at least 12 obstacles which may vary in height between 1.40m and 1.60m. The spread obstacles must have spreads of between 1.50m to two metres (2.20m for the triple bar). At least two vertical obstacles must be provided with a minimum height of 1.60m. At Events where the Schedule indicates that the height of obstacles in a qualifying Competition, e.g. the Grand Prix at a CSI3\*, is 1.50m, a special mention may be added to the Event Schedule that if the Competition is listed as a qualifying Competition for the Olympic Games, **the World** or Continental **Championship**, the compulsory two verticals at 1.60m will be included in the course without it being considered to have exceeded the dimensions listed in the Schedule.
  7. NFs unable to send complete teams to any of the CSIOs will be allowed to enter individuals who will be allowed to compete "*hors concours*" in the Nations Cup Competition.
  8. In exceptional circumstances, if an NF finds it impossible for its Athletes to qualify as above, it may request the FEI to send a foreign assessing delegate at the expense

of the NF to assess the level of performance, at a special qualifying Competition; permission for a special qualifying Competition may be granted by the Jumping Committee. Special qualifying Competitions should be held at a CSI or a CSIO and must be run in accordance with the following FEI protocol.

9. At Nations Cup, FEI World Cup™ and Grand Prix Competitions at selected CSI/CSIO 3\*/4\*/5\* Events the Foreign Judge is responsible for ensuring that the course is built to the required dimensions and will confirm in his report to the FEI that the minimum requirements for obtaining Certificates of Capability have been achieved.
10. Certificates of Capability must be received by the FEI for Athletes and Horses not later than the date fixed for nominated entries or date fixed by the FEI. Athletes and Horses for whom Certificates of Capability have not been received will not be allowed to start.
11. Any and all "*hors concours*" participation provided for directly or indirectly in the present Annex and/or in any special Rules of the Jumping Discipline are in compliance with the permissible exceptions as per Article 117.5 of the GRs.
12. The report of the assessing foreign delegate must be sent to the FEI Secretary General who in turn will send a copy to the Chair of the Jumping Committee. The NFs of the qualified Horses and Athletes will be informed by the FEI immediately after the qualification is given.

## **2.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

Resultaten van atleet en paard worden apart in aanmerking genomen. Het is dus niet verplicht om de minima als combinatie te behalen.

Atleet en paard dienen minstens het volgende resultaat te behalen:

1 x foutloos (hindernissen en tijd) in basisomloop of eerste ronde in een GP 4\* of 5\*

**OF**

1 x 1 foutloze ronde (hindernissen en tijd) tijdens een Nations Cup competitie op een 4\* of 5\*

Alle combinaties dienen vormbehoud te tonen tijdens de laatste 6 weken voor de WEG in overleg met de team manager.

### 3. Dressuur (12 – 16/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

#### **3.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 1 January 2017  
End: 13 August 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018

**Definite entries:** 3 September 2018

**Minimum qualification criteria** (art 450 Dressage Rules)

#### **Teams and Individuals**

In order to qualify for participation at the 2018 FEI World Dressage Championships, Athletes and Horses must have attained (as a combination) a result of at least 66% attributed by the Ground Jury and by any two different FEI 5\* Dressage Judges, of a nationality other than that of the Athlete, in a Grand Prix at two different CDI3\*/4\*/5\*/CDI-W or CDIO events during the qualification period.

#### **3.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

Enkel de resultaten van combinaties atleet/paard worden in aanmerking genomen.

Selectieperiode: Start: 1 januari 2017  
Einde: 13 augustus 2018

De combinatie dient tijdens de selectieperiode 2 x 69% te behalen in de dressuurproef Grand Prix of Grand Prix Special tijdens CDIO ,CDI-W of CDI 3\*of meer, waarbij er rekening zal gehouden worden met het deelnemersveld en dit geëvalueerd zal worden door de team manager. CDI-W resultaten (indoor) kunnen slechts voor één van de twee gestelde criteria (69%) gelden.

Minstens 1 resultaat moet behaald zijn in 2018 tijdens een outdoorwedstrijd.

In 2018 dienen alle combinaties vormbehoud te tonen in overleg met team manager.

## 4. Eventing (13 – 16/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **4.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

<b>Qualification Period:</b>	Start:	1 January 2017
	End:	13 August 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018

**Definite entries:** 3 September 2018

**Minimum Eligibility Requirements** (art 521 FEI Eventing Rules 2017)

For Championships all Minimum Eligibility Requirements\* must be achieved as a combination as follows, NF requirements + (1 CCI 4\*) or (1 CCI 3\* + 1 CI 3\*), for World Championship format.

\* A Minimum Eligibility Requirement is achieved by completing a Competition within minimum parameters of all round performance as follows:

a) Dressage Test: not more than 67 penalty points.

b) Cross Country Test:

- A clear round at obstacles (activating a maximum of one frangible device will maintain the MER result on Cross Country)
- Not more than 75 seconds exceeding the optimum time in the Cross Country Test for one, two and three star level Competitions and 100 seconds in the case of four star level Competitions.

c) Jumping Test: not more than 16 penalties at obstacles.

Note: If two Minimum Eligibility Requirements are used to qualify for a Championship, both of them must be achieved with a clear round on Cross Country obstacles.

### **4.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

In 2018 dienen alle combinaties vormbehoud te tonen in overleg met team manager.

## 5. Para-equestrian dressuur (18 - 22/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **5.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 1 January 2017  
End: 13 August 2018  
in addition to the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018

**Definite entries:** 10 September 2018

**Minimum qualification criteria** (art 8451 Para-Equestrian Dressage Rules)

#### **Qualifying events:**

Any CPEDI 3\* or 4\* event during the qualification period in addition to the Rio 2016 Paralympic Games.

#### **Qualification score:**

All Athlete/Horse combinations must have attained (as a combination) a minimum 62 % score attributed by the Ground Jury in a Team test or Individual Championship test one time.

### **5.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

Enkel de resultaten van combinaties atleet/paard worden in aanmerking genomen.

Selectieperiode: Start: 1 januari 2017  
Einde: 13 augustus 2018

2 x tijdens eenzelfde CPEDI3\* minstens 138 punten halen over de proeven "par equipe" en "individuele" (dus punten van beide proeven opgeteld).

Minstens 1 resultaat moet behaald zijn in 2018.

In 2018 dienen alle combinaties vormbehoud te tonen in overleg met de chef d'équipe.

## 6. Endurance (12/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **6.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 12 September 2016  
End: 13 July 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 July 2018

**Definite entries:** 3 September 2018

#### **Minimum qualification criteria** (art 816 Endurance Rules)

Horses:

816.3.9 Horses must have graduated through the qualifying processes outlined above for Novice and CEI-Star qualifying up to, and including, the distance of the event for which a Certificate of Capability is sought.

816.3.10 Horses must have successfully completed at least 3 CEI 2\* events or higher.

816.3.11 Of these 3 CEI events, at least one must be at the, minimum speed of 14kph, and the same distance and time frame as the 4-Star Championship and achieved no earlier than 24 months prior to, no later than the close of nominated entries for Championship and/or 60 days prior to the event, whichever comes first. This one ride must be in combination with the nominated Athlete unless that Athlete is a Senior Elite Endurance Athlete. In such cases, the horse can be ridden by any other applicable Athlete.

#### **Athletes:**

816.3.12 To achieve Senior Elite Athlete status, Athletes must have successfully completed a minimum of ten CEI 3\* 160km events or higher. To maintain Senior Elite Athlete status, Athletes must successfully complete at least one CEI3\* 160 km within every successive 24 months.

816.3.13 Riders who receive any form of a suspension as defined under the FEI General Regulations (Penalties) or have committed an offense under the FEI Equine Anti-Doping and Control Medication regulations, will automatically lose their Elite Status and will be required to re-qualify again by completing ten CEI3\* events commencing either after the period of suspension or after the 'fast track' decision is finalised.

816.3.14 Athletes must have graduated through the qualifying processes outlined above for Novice and CEI-Star qualifying up to, and including, the distance of the event for which a Certificate of Capability is sought.

816.3.15 Athletes must have successfully completed at least 5 CEI 2\* events or higher.

816.3.16 Of those 5 CEI events, one must be at the minimum speed of 14kph and the same distance, weight and time frame as the 4\* Championship, achieved no earlier than 24 months prior to, no later than the close of nominated entries for Championship and/or 60 days prior to the event, whichever comes first. This one ride must be in combination with the nominated horse unless that Athlete is a Senior Elite Endurance Athlete.

*Recording and Proof of Qualification:* Approved records must be provided for Rider/Horse results for eventual insertion into FEI Database/Passports as required. However, the ultimate responsibility for proof still remains with each NF.



## **6.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

Selectieperiode:                      Start:                      1 januari 2017  
Einde:                                      13 juli 2018

Combinaties die minimum 1 van de drie onderstaande minima halen zijn selecteerbaar. De chef d'équipe zal communiceren in welke categorie de verschillende internationale wedstrijden vallen die in aanmerking komen.

### **CEI met vlak parcours:**

Tijdens de selectieperiode dient de combinatie minstens geslaagd te zijn in één 160km wedstrijd (die in aanmerking komt) aan een gemiddelde van minstens 18km/u.

Combinaties die het criteria enkel in 2017 behaalden dienen in 2018 als bewijs van vormbehoud te slagen in een CEI van minstens 100km.

### **CEI met parcours met hellingen:**

Tijdens de selectieperiode dient de combinatie minstens geslaagd te zijn in één 160km wedstrijd (die in aanmerking komt) aan een gemiddelde van minstens 17km/u.

Combinaties die het criteria enkel in 2017 behaalden dienen in 2018 als bewijs van vormbehoud te slagen in een CEI van minstens 100km.

### **CEI met bergachtig parcours:**

Tijdens de selectieperiode dient de combinatie minstens geslaagd te zijn in één 160km wedstrijd (die in aanmerking komt) aan een gemiddelde van minstens 16km/u.

Combinaties die het criteria enkel in 2017 behaalden dienen in 2018 als bewijs van vormbehoud te slagen in een CEI van minstens 100km.

## 7. Reining (12-15/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **7.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 1 January 2017  
End: 13 August 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018  
**Definite entries:** 3 September 2018

#### **Minimum qualification criteria** (art 303 Reining Rules)

To be eligible to compete either as a member of a team or as an individual at the 2018 FEI World Equestrian Games, an Athlete must be qualified as FEI 3\* Athlete (Art. 302.5.1) and achieve a minimum average score of 70 at two out of three different CRI3\* (Championships excluded), all completed with no elimination, disqualification or withdrawal, during the qualification period.

One of the qualifying results as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

Nations who enter a Team must have organized a CRI of any level or an FEI Reining Championship in their home country during the qualification period. It is not compulsory for the Team members to have participated in this CRI/CH.

An NF that is not able to send a team may send up to two individual Athletes and two Horses who have achieved the minimum qualification criteria as stated above.

### **7.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

KBRSF zal maximum 4 combinaties selecteren.

Selectieperiode: Start: 1 januari 2017  
Einde: 13 augustus 2018

Ruiters kunnen hun minima behalen met een ander paard dan dat waarmee zal deelgenomen worden aan het WK.

Om in aanmerking te komen voor deelname als individu of teamlid moet de ruiter op 2 verschillende CRI's een score halen van minstens 70.  
Minstens 1 resultaat moet behaald worden in 2018.

Vanaf 3 maanden voor het WK mogen de paarden enkel nog geschoold worden waarbij ze alleen 0 scores rijden.

## 8. MENNEN (21-23/09/2018)

Definite Entries:

### **8.1. FEI Kwalificatie**

**Qualification Period:** Start: 1 January 2017  
End: 13 August 2018

**Nominated entries:** 13 August 2018

**Definite entries:** 10 September 2018

**Minimum qualification criteria** (in conjunction with art 913 and 914.1-6 of FEI Driving Rules 2017)

#### **Drivers**

At two (2) combined driving events, 3\* Drivers must achieve a score of 65 points or less in the Dressage test (Test 3\*B HP4) and have successfully completed (without Elimination, Disqualification or Retirement) all three competitions (Dressage, Cones, Marathon) in their own class.

One of the qualifying results as defined above must be achieved no earlier than on the 1<sup>st</sup> January of the year in which the Championships take place and no later than the end date of the qualification period.

Art 914.2 – Qualification results can be obtained at CAIO4\*, CAI3\* and CAI2\* (see Article 913) – Four-in-hand Horses.

Maximum Driven penalty points allowed at the Championships in Dressage as per Art 914.4: 75 points. Note: Above 75 points and Drivers will not be allowed to start the Marathon. Dressage test 3\*B HP4 will be run at the FEI World Equestrian Games 2018.

### **8.2. KBRSF Selectiecriteria**

Selectieperiode: Start: 1 januari 2017  
Einde: 13 augustus 2018

Om selecteerbaar te zijn dient de menner:

Deel uit te maken van het team dat op het EK te Göteborg 2017 minstens een top-drie plaats heeft behaald.

#### **EN**

In 2018 dient de menner minstens 1 resultaat op een CAI neer te zetten met volgende minima:

Dressuur: minder dan 56 strafpunten behalen

#### **EN**

Marathon: score van maximum 115% in vergelijking met de beste score in marathon

#### **EN**

Vaardigheid: maximum 6 punten verschil met de beste score in vaardigheid

Elke menner kan met max. met 5 paarden deelnemen aan de WEG.
