Athletes can be tested at any FEI Event, by the FEI or by other Anti-Doping Organisations with Testing jurisdiction. The FEI Anti-Doping Rules for Human Athletes (ADRHA) are published on the FEI's website at <https://inside.fei.org/content/anti-doping-rules>.

3. INVITATIONS

The FEI World Championships 2022 in Pratoni del Vivaro are open to all National Federation (NF) who are members of the Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI). If a NF doesn't declare their participation within the set entry period, then they may only do so with permission from the FEI and the Organising Committee (OC).

All persons traveling to the FEI World Championships 2022 in Pratoni del Vivaro (Rome) must check on the following website <https://vistoperitalia.esteri.it/home.aspx> to see if they need a Visa to enter, information can be with clear details regarding the procedures that need to be followed.

4. ENTRIES

Entries for the FEI World Championships must be in accordance with the FEI General Regulations Art. 116.2. You will find below the exact dates by which entries must be received, all the entries should be submitted and will be processed through the FEI Entry System.

4.1 Nominated entries

According to FEI General Regulations Art 116.2.2.i, the list of Nominated Entries can consist of a higher number of Athletes and Horses than the Definite Entries. All nominated entries must be submitted via the **FEI Entry System**.

W-CH/Eventing 15th August 2022 before midnight (CEST)

Each NF may submit a Nominated Entries list of maximum of three (3) times the number of Athletes and Horses: **15 Athletes and 15 Horses**

W-CH/Driving 22th August 2022 before midnight (CEST)

Each NF may enter a maximum of six Four-in-Hand Athletes with a maximum of ten Horses per Four-in-Hand on the nominated entry list and a maximum of **3 Four-in-hand Athletes** with a maximum of **5 Horses per Four-in-hand** on the definite entry list. The host country and NFs who have submitted a Nominated Entry for a Team may be allowed, from the 25th August, to enter up to 3 individual additional entries by the **29th August** midnight (CEST). Art 927.

4.2 Certificate of Capability

National Federations must download their Certificate of Capability through the FEI Online Entry System and send a signed version to the FEI declaring that their Athlete and Horse have fulfilled their national requirements and reached FEI requirements by the date of the nominated entries.

15th August 2022 before midnight (CEST) for W-CH Eventing

22nd August 2022 before **midnight (CEST) for W-CH Driving**

4.3 Definite Athlete Numbers

To assist in planning (confirming numbers and **timetables**) the OC is asking NFs to give an indication on **15th August for W-CH Eventing and 22nd August for W-CH Driving** the Number of Athletes and Horses they intend to submit at the Definite Entries per discipline. **No names are required** – sport@pratoni2022.it.

4.4 Definite Entries

Each National Federation must choose from its list of nominated entries and confirm up to the maximum of its entitlement of starters. After the definite entries have been sent in, substitutions of Athletes and/or Horses from the list of nominated entries may only be made with the express permission of the Organising Committee and in accordance with relevant Sport Rules (Art. 116.3.2), but never less than two hours preceding the first Horse Inspection.

W- CH/Eventing 5th September 2022 midnight (CEST)

Each NF may enter a maximum of **5 Athletes and 5 Horses**

W- CH/Driving 12th September 2022 midnight (CEST)

Each NF may enter a maximum of **6 Athletes and 30 Horses**

NFs should log into the FEI Entry System and select their Definite Entries and confirm the list.

Entries not submitted in accordance with the process summarised above and as detailed through the FEI Entry System will not be accepted.

5. SUBSTITUTIONS

According to FEI General Regulations, nominated entries must include a list of the names of Athletes and Horses from which the Definite Entries and any substitutions will be chosen.

All substitutions must come from the NF's list of Nominated Entries and submitted in accordance with the FEI General Regulation Art. 121.3 and as specified in the relevant discipline regulations:

Eventing FEI Eventing Rules 2022 art. 509.2.2 and 530.2
Driving FEI Driving Rules 2022 art. 946 – one hour prior the Horse Inspection

6. ENTRY FEES

Entry fees must be paid in **Euros** by NFs no later than:

7th September 2022 before 17:00 (CEST) for WCH Eventing
14th September 2022 before 17:00 (CEST) for WCH Driving

Chef d'Equipe must provide contact information for the persons responsible for payments. Athletes whose entry fees have not been paid will not be permitted to compete.

Horse passports will not be returned until all fees and charges have been paid.

7. RULES FOR PARTICIPATIONS

All Chefs de Mission, Chefs d'Equipe, Athletes, Horse Owners, employees, Grooms and accompanying persons are requested to acknowledge and to adhere to the FEI Code of Conduct and all applicable FEI rules and regulations. Violations will be dealt with by the respective Ground Jury or FEI Tribunal depending on the nature of the violations.

Upon arrival all Athlete and Chefs d' Equipe are required to submit signed copies of the FEI Code of Conduct and Athlete Waivers to the Show Office. (Appendix 1 & 2)

In accordance with the FEI Regulations Art. 135.1 the OC reserves the right to use Athlete/Horse images produced during the Championships for promotional purposes.

The full version of the FEI Code of Conduct for Welfare of the Horse can be obtained from the FEI's website.

8. VENUE

All discipline competitions of the FEI World Championships 2022 will take place at Centro Equestre Ranieri di Campello - Pratoni del Vivaro – Rocca di Papa – Rome.

8.1 Training Areas

Training areas and practice obstacles will be available to Athletes on the competition venue according to a timetable. Riding or driving will not be permitted outside these areas, all the training areas will be overseen by FEI Stewards.

8.3 Motorised or Electric Vehicles and Bicycles on Venue

No motorised or electric vehicles (motorbikes, Segways etc) will be permitted on the venue. Bicycles and e-bikes will be permitted on the venue in designated areas only (Pratoni is a protected natural park), with parking available in the back of house areas; bikes will not be allowed in the stables and/or commercial village and cross country/marathon area. Wheelchairs will be permitted.

Driving only:

- Nations will be allowed to have 1 golf cart if they will have between 1-3 Drivers and 2 golf carts if they will have between 4-6 Drivers
- Golf carts will be allowed in the Marathon area only during the days before the Marathon - Tuesday to Friday
- NFs can bring their own golf carts, but the OC will also provide contacts of golf cart rental agencies where NFs will be able to rent vehicles
- Bikes will not be allowed in the Marathon area at any time

9. LIABILITY & INSURANCE

To the greatest extent permitted by law, the OC and the FEI declines any liability for property or pecuniary damage which may happen to visitors, Athletes, grooms and Horse owners except were caused by the gross negligence or reckless disregard of the OC, the FEI, their delegates or their assistants. The OC and the FEI also declines any liability for theft, fire or other incidents except arising from the gross negligence or reckless disregard of the OC, the FEI or their delegates or assistants.

By making the Definite Entries, each Athlete declares that he/she has taken notice of the schedule and exclusion of the liability as set out in the schedule and that the Athlete explicitly agrees therewith. All Athletes and Chefs d'Equipe to sign and submit the waiver to the Show Office upon arrival. (See Appendix 2)

10. ADVERTISING AND PUBLICITY ON ATHLETES AND HORSES

All participants must comply with Art. 135 of the FEI General Regulations.

The FEI Chief Steward is responsible for ensuring that FEI Regulations relating to Art. 135 are respected by Athletes, who not complying with Art. 135 will not be permitted to enter the arena during the competition (Eventing Rules Art. 541).

In addition, certain provisions apply in relation to the use of the FEI World Championships Pratoni 2022 logo and name. For further information see Appendix 3.

11. STABLES SAFETY AND SECURITY

- Smoking will be strictly prohibited in the stable area
- Open fires will be strictly prohibited
- Dogs will not be allowed in the stable area
- Carriages will not be allowed in the stable area
- Open space and entry ways between the stables may not obstructed by equipment
- No one will be allowed to stay in the stables overnight unless authorized under Veterinary Regulations art. 1020.7

12.PETS

We strongly advise you not to bring dogs to the venue. If dogs are present they must always be kept on a leash and will not be allowed in the stables area. Art. 109.14 of FEI General Regulations will be applied: "If allowed at the Event, all dogs must be leashed and affixed to a human or stationary object. Violation of this rule will incur a fine of CHF 100 per offence and, in case of a repeated offence at the Event, may lead to exclusion from the Venue."

13.CEREMONIES, INTERVIEWS

13.1 Medal and Prize Giving Ceremonies

All medallists will be obliged to take part in the official medal ceremonies. The ceremonies will take place immediately following each final competition and will include only medal winners with their winning Horses and the Chefs d'Equipe in the case of team competitions.

13.2 Mixed Zone, Press Conferences and Interviews

All Chefs de Mission, Chefs d'Equipe, Athletes, team personnel and especially medallists and placed athletes are requested to make themselves available for interviews when requested by the FEI World Championships Pratoni2022 Media Team.

In addition, all Athletes will be obliged to pass through the mixed zone as soon as possible after competing, allowing time for cooling down their horses first.

Any athlete requested to attend a post-competition press conference, or any other press conference, by the FEI World Championships Pratoni2022 Media Team is obliged to do so.

13.3 Kiss & Cry

A Kiss & Cry area will be available at each competition arena, with a maximum of 10 accreditation holders allowed in the area. It is the responsibility of the Chef d'Equipe to administer the use of the Kiss & Cry.

2. After the tollbooth, turn left toward Artena
3. At the main traffic light turn right towards Artena Albano / Rocca di Papa

Chefs d'Equipe are required to submit the signed copies of the Code of Conduct to the Show Office upon arrival.

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Fédération Equestre Internationale (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct for the Welfare of the Horse and to always acknowledge and accept that the welfare of the Horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

- At all stages during the preparation and training of competition Horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good Horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
- Horse and Athletes must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and misuse of aids.
- Events must not prejudice Horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the Horse for onward travel after the event.
- Every effort must be made to ensure that Horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
- The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their area of expertise.

18.3 APPENDIX 3 – ATHLETE WAIVER

Chefs d'Equipe are required to submit the signed copies of Athlete Waiver to the Show Office upon arrival.

This document waives important legal rights. Read it carefully before signing.

I hereby state unequivocally that in consideration for authorization to compete in the FEI World Championships Pratoni 2022: I AGREE that my participation is voluntary and that I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports including the Championships involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including but not limited to broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, social and economic loss, and/ or even death (“Harm”). I represent that I have the requisite training, coaching and abilities to safely compete in the Games and that I am in good health and proper physical condition for participation at the Games. I further agree and warrant that if, at any time, I believe the conditions to be unsafe, I will immediately discontinue further participation and report such unsafe conditions to officials. To the greatest extent permitted by law I AGREE to release the Fédération Equestre Internationale (“FEI”), the FEI World Championships Pratoni 2022 Organising Committee, as well as all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers and affiliated organizations, sponsors, advertisers, owners and lessors of any premises as well as any and all event participants (“Released Parties”) from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, except where such Harm is caused by the gross negligence or wilful misconduct of the Released Parties. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the conditions of the grounds on which the Championships take place and the negligence of the Released Parties. There may be OTHER RISKS either not known to me or not readily foreseeable at this time; and I FULLY ACCEPT AND ASSUME ALL SUCH RISKS AND ALL RESPONSIBILITY FOR ANY LOSSES, COSTS, AND DAMAGES I incur as a result of such risks. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) the Released Parties and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, except where such harm is caused by the gross negligence or wilful misconduct of the Released Parties, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Championships. I have read the FEI Rules about protective equipment, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that the Released Parties strongly encourage me to do so while WARNING that no protective equipment can guard against all injuries or Harm. I AGREE that if I am injured at the Games, the medical personnel treating my injuries may provide information on my injury and treatment to the OC on the official accident/injury report form.

By signing, I confirm that I have read this agreement, that I fully understand its terms and contents, including the fact that I have given up substantial rights by signing it. I also acknowledge that I am signing this document of my own free will and without any inducement or assurance of any nature and intend it to be a complete and unconditional release of all liability to the greatest extent allowed by law and agree that if any portion of this agreement is held to be invalid, the balance, notwithstanding, shall continue in full force and effect. I also agree to be bound by all FEI and OC applicable rules, including but not limited to, the equine anti-doping and controlled medication regulations and any and all rules applicable to the Championships.

However, NFs may produce media guides, develop their own web content and distribute press releases regarding their participation in the FEI World Championships Pratoni – Roma 2022. Such content may include the logo and/or name of a NF's sponsor. However, NFs must ensure that the use of their sponsor's logo/name does not imply any association between the NF Sponsor and the FEI World Championships Pratoni – Roma 2022.
